- I know that:
- a plant's stem holds the plant up and carries the water and nutrients from the roots to the leaves and flowers
 - deciduous trees lose their leaves each year
 - evergreen trees keep their green leaves all year round.

- A habitat is a place where living things, such as animals and plants, can find all of the things they need to survive.
- Microhabitats are very small habitats where minibeasts may live.
